In this lesson we will study chapters 38 and 39 of the book of Ezekiel.

As before, we will continue with the <u>next</u> major events in the founding of the modern nation of Israel.

We will then continue with chapter 38, where we will be introduced to Gog, and we will see a yet-future battle between a host of nations and Israel.

Chapter 39 will retell and add detail to the story told in chapter 38. We will hear of the end of Gog, and the LORD's plans for the nation of Israel.

As we are <u>now</u> talking about <u>future</u> events, even though they were written over <u>2600</u> years ago, we <u>no longer</u> have the advantage of <u>hindsight</u> to guide our evaluation of the passages that we are studying. <u>Multiple</u> possibilities exist for the prophecies in chapters 38 and 39. And we are again in an area where there is a great deal of <u>controversy</u>.

I will do <u>my best</u> in the time we have to point out the major positions that have good scholarship behind them. I will give you <u>my</u> opinion as to what <u>I</u> think is going on. Nevertheless, you should all be Bereans and <u>not</u> trust what I say, but do <u>your own</u> study.

# • Ezekiel, a priest, a prophet, and a watchman in Babylon continues his ministry to the exiles – between 586 and 574 B.C. • Studied the Ottoman Empire, the waves of Jewish immigration to "Palestine", the Balfour Declaration, and the San Remo Conference • The LORD declared the coming desolation of Edom • The LORD prophesied the return of the nation of Israel – initially without the Spirit

### Let's review.

Ezekiel, a priest from Jerusalem, was taken to Babylon in Nebuchadnezzar's second conquest in 598 B.C. As the LORD's prophet and watchman Ezekiel is <u>continuing</u> to give the LORD's prophetic messages regarding the <u>future</u> of the nation of Israel to the exiles in Babylon. The year is sometime between 586 and 574 B.C. as we begin our study.

The <u>last time</u> we met, we reviewed the history of the Ottoman Empire, which existed for 600 years and which had control over the land that was called Palestine.

We examined the waves of Jewish immigration to Palestine that took the Jewish population from around <u>25,000</u> in 1880 to <u>650,000</u> on the eve of independence in 1948.

Next we studied the <u>Balfour Declaration</u> and its call for a <u>national home</u> for the Jewish people in the land of Palestine. We also heard the Balfour Declaration was incorporated into <u>both</u> the Sevres (sāy vǎh') Peace Treaty that ended the Ottoman Empire, <u>and</u> the League of Nations Mandate for Palestine.

The San Remo Conference we discussed was the location for the assigning of the <u>Mandate for Palestine</u> to Britain. We also saw that the region allocated for the eventual nation of Israel was <u>much</u> smaller than what was <u>originally</u> intended.

Following the history of Israel we returned to the book of Ezekiel, where chapter 35 gave us a more in depth look at God's pronouncement of the <u>coming desolation</u> of the nation of Edom.

Then in chapters 36 and 37, the LORD's focus <u>shifted</u> to the <u>restoration</u> of the nation of Israel and the gathering of the Jewish people from <u>all</u> the nations where they had been <u>scattered</u>.

We stood with Ezekiel in the Valley of dry bones, and we watched and heard as those bones came together and took on flesh and lived again, we even had <u>musical accompaniment</u>.

We learned that the modern nation of Israel is the <u>fulfillment</u> of the prophesy in Ezekiel, but that the current nation is flesh and bone <u>without</u> the spirit. We <u>also</u> learned that the spirit <u>would</u> come to Israel <u>and</u> the Jewish people after a <u>significant</u> event occurs. <u>Today</u>, we will study that event...

Now we will continue our history of the modern nation of Israel.

Over the next few years after the Balfour Declaration there was a <u>shift</u> in the British government to an <u>anti-Zionist</u> posture. The British policymakers began to think that is was <u>more</u> in their interest to have an alliance with the <u>Arabs</u> than with the Jews. Many officials felt that is was <u>wrong</u> to go against the local Arab opinion by supporting Zionism. Therefore, even though the Prime Minister, David Lloyd George, and Lord Balfour continued to be supporters, the rest of the government had <u>very few</u> pro-Zionists.

The British War Office and the Foreign Office were populated with "Arabists". This consisted of a rather large group in the Foreign Office who had "spent their lives learning to speak Arabic". They went to places like Cairo and Khartoum, and they were <u>enamored</u> with the "noble" Bedouin. They also wanted to create a <u>continuous</u> overland empire from South Africa to India, and this <u>required</u> the land of Palestine. Hence, they and the military leaders, such as General Allenby and General Money, worked strongly against the Balfour Declaration and refused to even allow its publication in Palestine.

Vladimir Jabotinsky, a Russian, Zionist activist, orator, and writer, at the time wrote, "Not in Russia, nor in Poland had there been such an intense and widespread atmosphere of hatred as prevailed in the British army in Palestine in 1919 and 1920."

One of the few genuine non-Jewish British establishment Zionists was Colonel Richard Meinertzhagen, the British chief of intelligence in the Middle East. Meinertzhagen felt that supporting a Jewish National Home would be good for Britain, and he wrote:

"The force of nationalism will challenge our position. We cannot befriend both Arab and Jew. My proposal is based on befriending the people who are more likely to be loyal friends – the Jews....Though, we have done much for the Arabs, they do not know the meaning of gratitude; moreover they would be a liability; the Jew would be an asset....The Jews have moreover proved their fighting qualities since the Roman occupation of Jerusalem. The Arab is a poor fighter, though an adept at looting, sabotage and murder.... [Mine] is a proposal to make our position in the Middle East more secure."

In 1920, the British Arabists tried to install their candidate, Feisel, as king of Syria, including Palestine. In order to pressure the British government into ending the Jewish National Home policy, they instigated "anti-Jew riots to impress on the Administration the unpopularity of the Zionist policy."

They recruited Haj Amin al-Husseini who led a group of Pan-Arabist radicals. And in early 1920, they put up posters saying that, "The Government is with us, Allenby is with us, kill the Jews; there is no punishment for killingJ ews." An Arab mob then killed six Jews and wounded 211.


When the Moslem religious leader post of Mufti of Jerusalem became vacant, Haj Amin al-Husseini ran and lost the election, coming in fourth. The British anti-Zionists deposed the winner and installed Husseini as the "Grand Mufti for life". Haj Amin al-Husseini was Yassar Arafat's uncle, and he was later a confident of Hitler's in crafting the "final solution" for the Jews.

The authority over Palestine was transferred from the Foreign Office to the Middle East Department at the Colonial Office. This department was headed by Sir John Evelyn Shuckburgh, who was "saturated with anti-Semitism" and he loathed Zionism and the Jews. At this point the minister for the Colonial Office was none other than Winston Churchill, who was outspoken in his sympathy for Zionism.

Shuckburgh and T.E. Lawrence, of Lawrence of Arabia fame, convinced Churchill that Transjordan, the majority portion of Palestine, had been promised to the Hashemites of Mecca during the war. This led in 1921 to the installation of Abdullah and his army as ruler of Transjordan, which was still considered part of Palestine.

The Colonial Office subordinates of Churchill believed that they were earning the Arabs loyalty. However, less than 2 months after the decision on Transjordan, Arab mobs again went on a rampage, and a number of Jews were murdered.

In 1922 Transjordan was detached from Palestine and later became the Hashemite Kingdom of Transjordan. We know this simply as Jordan today.



The original British Mandate including the Balfour Declaration in April of 1922 provided for an area of 43,000 square miles. As we discussed Britain had already demarcated the part of the mandate east of the Jordan river as "Transjordan."

### (next)

In August of 1922, the League of Nations accepted the British demarcation of Transjordan, as discussed in the <a href="The Churchill ("Command")">The Churchill ("Command")</a> White Paper. About 32,500 square miles, roughly 76% of the area of the Jewish National home, were given to Transjordan. The Jewish National Home now had an area of about 10,500 square miles. Jews were barred from living or owning property east of the Jordan river, violating Article 15 of <a href="The British Mandate for Palestine">The British Mandate for Palestine</a>; which read, "No discrimination of any kind shall be made between the inhabitants of Palestine on the ground of race, religion or language. No person shall be excluded from Palestine on the sole ground of his religious belief." In 1946, Britain granted independence to Jordan, in violation of Article 25, but by that time however, the League of Nations was no more.

### (next)

In 1947, the <u>UN Partition Plan for Palestine: General Assembly, Resolution 181</u>, divided the remaining area of the British Mandate, about 10,000 square miles, into a "Jewish state" and an "Arab state." The Jewish state was to get about 5,500 square miles of the area, which was 12.8% of the originally promised land area. The Arab state was to get about 4,500 square miles. The Arab state was divided into three areas, and the Jewish state into two areas. The areas were theoretically contiguous, touching at two points. The Arabs <u>rejected</u> the partition plan and attacked Israel when it declared its independence.

Now let's return to our study of the Book of Ezekiel.

### The Players – part 1

So, let's read chapter 38 of Ezekiel verses 1 – 6. (Read verses 1-6.)

Chapter 38 begins with the LORD telling Ezekiel to set his face toward a <u>ruler</u> and a <u>land</u>. This is something we have seen The LORD do <u>before</u> against Pharaoh and Egypt. However, <u>this</u> time the LORD is speaking about a previously <u>unmentioned</u> ruler and land. What is <u>worse</u>, is that the LORD speaks of a <u>number</u> of other nations as well, even though we have only heard of a few of them, such as Cush and Put.

So just who are these nations? Do they exist today?

We actually <u>do</u> have mention of the primary nations in this section all the way back in Genesis 10, which is often called the "Table of Nations".

### Gen 10:2 (KJV)

<sup>2</sup>The sons of Japheth; Gomer, and Magog, and Madai, and Javan, and Tubal, and Meshech, and Tiras.

These are in fact the <u>ancient tribal</u> names for these peoples and nations. We know in this list that Madai became the Medes, and that Javan became the Greeks. So what about the nations found here that <u>match</u> the nations in Ezekiel chapter 38? Unfortunately, they are <u>not</u> so well known, but we <u>do</u> have references that help us to identify some of them.

The <u>only</u> reference <u>outside</u> of Ezekiel in the Old Testament for a Gog is in 1 Chr 5:4 for a descendant of Reuben. This seems to have <u>no</u> relation to the Gog of chapter 38. In the New Testament there is <u>one</u> reference to Gog and Magog in Revelation 20:8, which speaks of the <u>final</u> battle with Satan at the <u>end</u> of the Millennium.

Commentaries <u>vary</u> as to who Gog is. Gog is called the Rosh Nasiy in Hebrew. Some writers <u>mispronounce</u> Rōsh as Rŏsh, and they say that this is really a proper name for the Ros or Rus, and hence this is indicating Russia. I <u>do</u> think that chapter 38 <u>is</u> speaking in part about Russia, but this is <u>not</u> why. I will <u>explain</u> why in a few moments. Instead, based upon the text of the chapter, I think it is apparent that Gog is a <u>title</u> rather than a name. I agree with most translations that indicate that Gog is the <u>chief</u> prince or ruler of Meshech and Tubal.

Therefore, Gog is the <u>title</u> of a <u>future</u> ruler, who may be living <u>now</u>, and who will be the primary leader of part of the land that was known in the <u>past</u> as Magog. Now let's see, if we can pin down Magog, Meshech, and Tubal.

# The Players — part 2 • Josephus and Herodotus (among others) were historians that wrote of these areas • Magog = Scythians — North of Black Sea — Some of the first horsemen — One of the ancestors of the Russian people • Meshech (Ukraine & Southern Russia) and Tubal (Georgia) — Meshech identified as Sarmatians by Herodotus — Tubal is associated with Iberians — Georgia today

We have extra-biblical sources, meaning outside of the Bible, that mention these nations.


Titus Flavius Josephus, a Jewish historian that worked for Rome had his <u>own</u> table of nations. In Josephus' work Antiquities, book 1 chapter 6, he says that Magog was the land of the <u>Scythians</u> [sith-ee-uh n]. The Scythians were one of the earliest horse riding people. They were supposedly very fine archers. They made incredible jewelry, and they were pretty ornery. They were one of the ancestors of the Russian people.

Herodotus in the fourth book of his history identifies Meshech and Tubal as Sarmatians and Muscovites, who occupied the north eastern area of what is now Russia.

Along with other early writers and archaeological evidence, it therefore <u>appears</u> that the land of <u>Magog</u> is an area that we would now call Russia as well as a number of the "Stan" states (i.e. Turkmenistan, Kazakhstan, etc.).

According to Herodotus Meshech is identified as the Sarmatians. Their territory, which was known as Sarmatia corresponded to the western part of greater Scythia (mostly modern Ukraine and Southern Russia, also to a smaller extent the north-eastern Balkans and the area around Moldova).

Tubal was the grandson of Noah through Japheth. Tubal is said to be the ancestor of the Caucasian Iberians. Modern day Georgians descended from the Caucasian Iberians. Today, Georgians claim that they came from the nations of Tubal, Togarmah, and Meshech.



According to Wikipedia, <u>not</u> always the best source, the Scythians were a group of Iranian people, known as the Eurasian nomads, who inhabited the western and central Eurasian steppes from about the 9th century BC until about the 1st century BC. Scythia was the Greek term for the grasslands north and east of the Black Sea.

A wealthy class known as the **Royal Scyths** ruled the western Scythians, which were based in what is modern-day Ukraine, Southern European Russia, and Crimea. The Scythians established and controlled a vast trade network connecting Greece, Persia, and China.

# The Players – part 3 Persia = Iran Cush = Ethiopia, Sudan Put = Libya, Algeria, Morocco, Tunisia Gomer = Western Turkey (Galatians), Cimmerians Togarmah (or Beth-Togarmah) = Eastern Turkey Sheba & Dedan = Saudi Arabia and the Arabian Peninsula Tarshish = Not known, but most feel it is either Great Britain or more likely Spain; possibly the World outside of Israel

The remaining nations that are mentioned also have modern equivalents:

Persia is modern day <u>Iran</u>. Actually, Iran was commonly called Persia <u>until</u> 1935. This is when Reza Shah <u>requested</u> that the International community refer to the country by its native name, Iran. Iran is home to 81 million people making it the 18<sup>th</sup> most populous country according to the UN.


Cush and Put are found in other places in the Bible, such as Genesis 10, 1 Chr 1:10, Ps 7, Isaiah 11:11, and Nah 3:9. Cush is usually identified with Ethiopia, and Put is usually identified with Libya, and your translation may list them as such. The area called Cush also includes Sudan. And Put also includes Algeria, Morocco, and Tunisia.

Gomer is associated with the Cimmerians, who were later called <u>Galatians</u>. This is the area of western Turkey. However, some commentators say the Cimmerians also would include Germany as well as Poland and Czechoslovakia.

Togarmah or Beth-Togarmah refers to the area of eastern Turkey.

Sheba and Dedan are mentioned as part of those who stand back and watch this attack occurring. Sheba and Dedan were the grandsons of Abraham through his 2<sup>nd</sup> wife, Keturah. They were sent into the area we know as Saudi Arabia and the Arabian Peninsula.

Where Tarshish was is not known with certainty. Most scholars place it in Great Britain or more likely in Spain. However, at least one writer states that Tarshish is the biblical term for the <u>West</u>. In other words, Tarshish may simply represent the world outside of Israel.



Here is a map showing the supposed location of the nations in chapter 38. I recognize that this map does <u>not</u> match all that we have discussed, but it is <u>reasonably</u> close.

Notice that the nations are coming at Israel from <u>all</u> directions. In fact, the LORD says that <u>He</u> will put <u>hooks</u> into the jaws of Gog and the leaders of these nations to <u>force</u> them to come!

### In the Latter Years

- Gog is to get his forces ready
- Gog is to be a defense for his allies
- This will occur "in the latter years", after Israel is restored to the land, and the land is once more productive
- Gog's forces will come like a storm to "seize spoil and carry off plunder"
- The other nations of the world will comment but not act

Now, let's read chapter 38 of Ezekiel verses 7–13. (Read verses 7-13.)

In verse 7, the LORD tells Gog to <u>get</u> ready and to <u>keep</u> ready. Gog is to assemble his forces and defend his allies . The LORD says that Gog is to do this because Gog is going to <u>need</u> his forces.

However, the LORD says that Gog will <u>not</u> need to muster his forces to <u>act</u> for a <u>very long time</u>. In fact, Gog will have to wait until the <u>latter</u> years. <u>When</u> is that?

The LORD says that the <u>latter years</u> will take place <u>when</u> the nation of Israel is "restored from war" and her people are <u>once more gathered</u> into her. <u>World War I</u> and <u>World War II</u> played <u>major</u> roles in the rebirth of the nation of Israel. The LORD also <u>indicates</u> that the land will once more be <u>productive</u> after it "<u>had</u> been a continual waste", and He says that it has "acquired livestock and goods". This <u>prosperity</u> will be an <u>enticement</u> for Gog.

So, the LORD says that a <u>thought</u> and an <u>evil</u> scheme will occur to Gog. That thought will be that Gog should <u>attack</u> Israel with his forces, because Gog believes that <u>for some reason</u> Israel is not prepared or adequately protected. And Gog will then come with a <u>massive</u> military force that will be like a <u>storm</u> cloud covering all the land.

At that time other nations, including Saudi Arabia will comment and perhaps complain to Gog, but they appear <u>not</u> to act. This sounds a great deal like the UN. By the way, Russia has veto power in the Security Council of the UN.

It is very interesting who is <u>not</u> included with the forces of Gog. We have just seen that Saudi Arabia is <u>not</u> an ally. Also, Egypt and Jordan are <u>not</u> mentioned. Why not?

Egypt and Jordan have <u>peace treaties</u> with Israel. And Saudi Arabia has actually had private discussions with Israel because the Saudis are <u>concerned</u> about Iran.

How did Ezekiel know this 2600 years ago? Ezekiel was told what to say by the LORD.

Now, let's read chapter 38 of Ezekiel verses 14 - 23. (Read verses 14-23.)

Ezekiel is told to prophesy to Gog and to tell him that Gog will know when Israel is back in the land and it is time.

When Gog and his army come against Israel, the LORD says that His <u>anger</u> will be roused. In the King James it says "my <u>fury</u> shall come up in my face". <u>Imagine</u> the anger of God directed at you...

In verse 16 the LORD says that Gog is coming against "my people" and "my land". It's high noon, and the Sheriff is back in town when the bad guys arrive.

The LORD will cause a great earthquake that will shake the <u>whole</u> earth, causing "<u>all</u> people who are on the face of the earth" to shake at <u>His</u> presence. I certainly don't want to experience that.

The LORD will cause the army of Gog to <u>turn against</u> each other, and the LORD will <u>pummel</u> the army with pestilence, rain, hailstones, fire, and sulfur. The LORD will make an <u>end</u> of Gog and his army.

So, <u>why</u> is the LORD against these nations? In fact, <u>why</u> will the LORD <u>compel</u> them, put <u>hooks</u> in their jaws, to bring them <u>against</u> the nation of Israel?

<u>Who</u> is the LORD speaking to in chapter 38? He is speaking to <u>Gog</u>! So, essentially the LORD is speaking directly to the leader of Russia. It <u>doesn't matter</u> whether the leader or the other nations <u>want</u> to get involved, because the LORD will <u>drag</u> them in.

Why would the LORD do this? As the LORD says 54 times in the Book of Ezekiel, "So they will know that I am the LORD." This will be <u>proof</u> to these nations, the rest of the world, and <u>most of all to Israel that the LORD is</u> GOD.

Please recognize that the LORD does <u>not</u> have to do this! He is <u>choosing</u> to give a <u>mighty object lesson</u> about who <u>He</u> is just like he did with the Exodus.

In the Exodus God <u>judged</u> Pharaoh, Egypt, and all their false gods, and there was <u>not</u> a thing that they could do about it. That lesson is <u>still</u> celebrated <u>today</u> by the Jewish people with the Passover celebration. <u>That</u> was a lesson to the <u>whole</u> world. Remember, even <u>40 years later</u>, Rahab in Jericho <u>had heard</u> what God had done to Egypt, and the people of Jericho were <u>very</u> afraid.

Well, here <u>again</u> the LORD will let the <u>whole</u> earth know <u>who</u> is LORD. And there is <u>not</u> one thing anyone can do about it. (next slide)

### Detail of the End of Gog

- The LORD will disarm Gog
- Burn weapons for 7 years
- Will send a fire on Magog and those who dwell securely in the coastlands
- Event will change the people of Israel, and all nations will know the LORD

Let's read chapter 39 of Ezekiel verses 1 – 20. (Read verses 1-20.)

Chapter 39 is a detailed description of the destruction of Gog and his forces as well as some other areas.

Ezekiel is <u>again</u> told to prophesy against Gog. <u>This</u> time the LORD lets us know that <u>He</u> will <u>disarm</u> Gog when Gog comes against Israel. So, whatever weapons Gog plans to use will <u>not</u> be effective. Arrows, might just be a metaphor for missiles, but that is just a <u>conjecture</u> on my part.

The LORD says that He will send a <u>fire</u> on Magog and those who dwell securely in the <u>coastlands</u>. So, the LORD plans <u>some</u> level of destruction on the land that spawned Gog. But, <u>what</u> is meant by those who dwell securely in the coastlands? We <u>don't</u> know who this refers to. Could it be the United States? Yes. But, it could mean any of a number of others.

In verse 7 the LORD says that <u>this</u> event will <u>change</u> the people of Israel. I should hope so! The LORD says He will <u>now</u> be known to Israel. The LORD also says that He will <u>no longer</u> let His holy name be <u>profaned</u>. I <u>don't</u> know <u>what</u> this means He will do to those that profane His name after this, but I would <u>not</u> recommend testing it. <u>Now</u>, <u>all</u> the nations, at least those that are left, will <u>know</u> the Holy one of Israel is <u>the</u> LORD.

Amazingly, the LORD says that the people of Israel will <u>burn</u> the weapons of Gog for 7 years, meeting <u>all</u> the energy needs of the nation of Israel. This is puzzling if we are talking conventional weapons, although there could be a great deal of liquid fuel for so massive an army, and Israel <u>is</u> a small country. It <u>could</u> also mean that nuclear weapons were used. But, the explanation regarding the remains of the army <u>may</u> give us a clue.

The LORD will give a valley for the burial of the army of Gog. The valley will be called the valley of Hamon-gog, or the multitude of Gog. It will take <u>7 months</u> to bury the remains. After this, there will be a group of <u>professionals</u> who will search for remains. If a traveler spots remains, they do <u>not</u> touch them. They mark the spot for the professionals who bury the remains down wind. This certainly gives the impression of a hazmat crew, which means it could be chemical, nuclear, or biological in nature.

The LORD also tells Ezekiel to speak to the birds so they will come to eat the remains of Gog's army. The language suggest that this is God's giving the army of Gog as a sacrifice to the birds.

Let's read chapter 39 of Ezekiel verses 21 – 29. (Read verses 21-29.)

The LORD says that He will set His glory among the nations, as He said in chapter 38:23. This will occur because <u>all</u> the nations will see the LORD's executed judgement. Was it possible in Ezekiel's day for even a <u>few</u>, let alone <u>all</u> nations to <u>see</u> God's judgement? No. But in <u>our</u> time, we can see whatever happens <u>anywhere</u> in the world.

Verse 22 says that once these events occur Israel will know the LORD from that day forward.

Additionally, Israel <u>and</u> the nations will <u>know</u> that the LORD had sent Israel into captivity and scattered them <u>because</u> of Israel's <u>sins</u>. The LORD will <u>restore</u> the "fortunes of Jacob" and "have mercy on the whole house of Israel".

Now, the LORD says that He will <u>forget</u> their <u>shame</u> and <u>treachery</u>. The LORD will ensure that <u>nothing</u> will make Israel afraid.

God also says that he will leave none of them in other nations anymore.

And at last, the LORD declares that He will pour out His Spirit upon the house of Israel.
